The Music Program

The Music Department at Seton is committed to offering high quality music education with the support of our peripatetic music tutors.

We cater for those who have music experience and those who are keen to learn a musical instrument for the first time (including vocals).

Students will be placed in our Specialist Music classes where, as part of the curriculum, both a practical and theoretical approach will be taught.

These students will become part of the College Ensembles which include: Flute Ensemble, Clarinet Ensemble, Classical Guitar Ensemble, Contemporary Guitar Ensemble, Concert Band, Choirs and Rock Bands – which are all free of charge and rehearse either at lunchtimes or before/after school.

There are a variety of performance and competition opportunities where students can showcase their talent and skills. These include: Assemblies, Concerts, Music Camp, Catholic Performing Arts Festival and various community events such as ANZAC Day.

Ensemble involvement is recognised in both the College Arts and House competitions.

Students are also encouraged to complete graded examinations through the AMEB or ABRSM examination boards.

Private Tuition Conditions

Private Tuition lessons are an essential part of developing your child's talent and interest but will incur an additional cost. To facilitate this the College is prepared to hire specialist tutors, but certain conditions apply:

- Lessons are 30 minutes long and take place during the school day. It is the responsibility of the student to attend each lesson at the appointed time.
- All students are required to purchase or hire their own musical instrument. We have a number of woodwind and brass instruments available for hire.
- Private tuition is a year-long commitment. If a student decides part way through the year that they wish to discontinue their lessons, the full annual fee is still payable.
