Uniform & Personal Appearance

Students are expected to wear the correct and complete uniform travelling to and from school, attending school, for physical education activities and when representing the College.

It is expected that our students will take pride in their personal appearance and be supported in this by their parents to ensure that uniforms are complete, clean, tidy, in good condition and fit well. Each student will thus be a credit to themselves, their family and the College.

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4 while winter uniform, which includes College blazer and tie, are worn in Terms 2 and 3. All students have the option of wearing long pants and shorts as part of the summer uniform.

Summer Uniform

College Dress (maximum 3cm above the top of the knee)
Short Grey College Socks
White Short Sleeve Crested Shirt (new untucked style compulsory for all Year 7s in 2024, and all other students by 2026)
Grey Shorts or Long Trousers (to be worn on the waist)

College Blazer
Tartan Skirt (maximum 3cm above the top of the knee)

White Blouse or White Short Sleeve Crested Shirt (new untucked style compulsory for all Year 7s in 2024, and all other students by 2026)

Shoes

Formal - Plain black polished leather lace-up shoes (no boots, high heels or runner style shoes) - Not sold at the Uniform Shop. See last page for sample shoes.

Sport - Lace Up Sport Shoes (not canvas or skate)

All students must arrive at Morning PCG wearing their full College Uniform. The only exception to this rule is if student has a before school College sport. Students will only have to get changed once in a day. Students who have PE / Dance Period 1 or 2 will be given time during Pastoral Care and then may wear their sports uniform all day. Students who have PE / Dance Periods 3 or 4 will get changed at recess into their sports uniform and then may wear their sports uniform all day. Students who have PE / Dance Periods 5 or 6 will get changed into their sports uniform at lunchtime and then be allowed to leave the College at the end of the school day in their sports uniform.

College Uniform

- Summer dresses and winter skirts should be a maximum of 3cm above the top of the knee.
- All top buttons must be done-up on the blouse/shirt. If new style untucked shirts are deemed too long, students will be asked to tuck them in.
- Shorts and trousers must be of the correct size and worn around the waist.
- When wearing a tie, the top button of the shirt should be done up.
- Older style shirts must be tucked into trousers.
- In winter, blazers must be worn to school, to assemblies, to guest speakers and on excursions.

- In summer, formal summer uniform is to be worn when representing the College.
- The College jumper may be worn in summer or winter.
- The College jumper may not be worn as part of the sports uniform
- The tracksuit top may be worn only as part of the sports uniform (not part of the formal summer or winter uniform)
- Socks are to be worn with the stripes showing (where applicable) and easily visible above the shoe line.
- Hats should be worn only during outside activities. Only a College approved hat is acceptable.

Hair

- The College's policy on hairstyles has been formulated giving due consideration to community expectations, hygiene and safety.
- Hair must be off the face at all times. Hair that is long enough to be tied back will be required to be tied back (no top knots – tied back not up) using only white, red or black ribbons, combs or bands.
- Hairstyles are to be neat, clean and appropriate to a College uniform. Extremes of colour and style are not acceptable, students should err on the side of conservative. Fad hair styles such as tracks, undercuts, streaked, bleached, spiked, mullet etc. are not suitable for school.
- Hair should not be inappropriately short or shaven - haircuts with No.1 blades are not acceptable.
- Students must be clean-shaven. Those not meeting requirements may be asked to shave at school.
- Students whose hair is unacceptable, due either to colour or cut, will be required to amend immediately.

General

- The only items of jewellery permitted are:
 - A wrist watch
 - A maximum of one plain metal (not stones or decorative) sleeper or stud per ear only. Other piercings, such as nose, eyebrow, facial etc are not acceptable.
 - Official school badges
 - A medi-alert bracelet (if required)
- A small plain item of Christian religious significance may be worn around the neck on a fine (not coarse) chain.
- Make-up is not to be worn. Nail varnish and lip-gloss must be clear and not discernible. Fake eye lashes are not acceptable.

Safety

- Hats are to be worn all year in all outdoor physical education and sport classes.
- Sunscreen should be worn.
- Students riding to or from school must wear a helmet.
- Safety equipment such as aprons and glasses supplied by the school must be worn as directed by teachers.

Final discretion on the appropriateness of uniform and presentation remains with the College Executive.

Parents and staff are expected to monitor and maintain the College uniform and to expect high standards of personal presentation.
