- Keep accurate records of student attendance, student progress, contact with parents, as well as all teaching and learning adjustments provided to students on SEQTA
- Role model and ensure adherence to College procedures
- Work collaboratively with other members of the faculty assisting in planning, programming and assessment
- Attend student reviews and Parent & Student/Teacher meetings
- Present pedagogical proficiency and motivational classroom practice. Seek and respond to feedback to support professional and personal growth
- Implement tailored programs for students who require additional, specific assistance
- Follow CEWA Executive Directives and College procedures including organising events, excursions and camps utilising Consent2Go

- Attend Professional Learning Communities (PLC), Staff Prayer & Briefings, College and Year Masses, Assemblies, Camps and College functions as required
- Participate in school-based professional learning activities
- Complete other duties as requested and at the discretion of the Principal
